



## Upcoming in Propel Rx 1.7 SP1

### What We're Fixing & Interim Solutions

The Pharmacy Technology Solutions (PTS) team is working diligently on fixes in Propel Rx. We will keep you posted on the enhancements and fixes your store should expect. Once the PTS team is ready to deploy a release to your store, you will receive an upgrade notice.

## What enhancements are coming in Propel Rx 1.7 SP1?

### Copy Mixture

- The ability to copy a Mixture Folder will be added to the Drug and Mixture Search and Mixture Search windows. When a Mixture is copied, most fields will be carried over including but not limited to the Ingredients, Master Formula, Custom Classes, and Attachments. The Name, Lot #, Expiry Date, Replacement DIN, and Inactive flag will not be carried over.

### Other Pharmacy Filter and Duplicate Pharmacy Validation

- In List Maintenance, the Filter for the Other Pharmacy list will be enhanced to check against more fields in a pharmacy record. You will be able to filter by Address, City, Phone, and Fax, in addition to the Pharmacy Name and Banner. Propel Rx will continue to check for duplicates when a new pharmacy record is added. However, the duplicate validation prompt will now trigger when the Pharmacy Name and Phone (or Fax) matches an existing record.

### Packaging Initials on the Vial Copy (Manitoba Only)

- In Manitoba, a second set of user initials will print to the left of the pharmacist's initials on the Half, Thermal, and Daily Laser vial labels. If Packaging is enabled, these initials will reflect the user who completed Packaging. If Packaging is not enabled, these initials will reflect the user who completed Data Entry. For Owe Balances, the user who processed the Owe Balance will be indicated.

### Skip All Interchangeables for a Batch

- A Skip All checkbox will be added to the Interchangeables Exceptions prompt that can appear when scheduling a batch. This checkbox will allow you to quickly skip the interchangeable evaluation for all drugs in the window. The Filter may be used in conjunction with this checkbox to selectively skip rows.



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## What fixes are coming in Propel Rx 1.7 SPI?

### Attachments

- When the Remove Attachment button is selected for a prescription attachment, the first page should not be removed by default if it's not the current page being displayed.

### Drug

- The Rank column in the Drug Folder Inventory tab should determine which supplier is used to automatically re-order a drug. Please note, the **Rank** and **Default** columns will be renamed to **Re-Order Choice** and **Default Price** respectively to provide better clarity on their functionality. The Default Price column determines which Supplier Price is used to calculate the cost for a prescription, if applicable.

### Forms

- The SIG on the Authorization Request form should reflect the most current SIG for the prescription. If the prescription is incomplete, the form captures the SIG entered in Rx Detail.

### Inventory

- When a Kohl & Frisch (K&F) purchase order is reconciled with a Received Quantity of 0 for one or more items, a prompt should appear with the option to re-order the unreceived items, and the purchase order should close.  
**Interim Solution:** manually close the purchase order and re-order the unreceived items.

### Patient

- In the Help window accessed from the Patient Folder Third Party tab, the phone number for Medavie Blue Cross should be up to date.

### Prescription

- In a coordination of benefits scenario, if a third party plan is skipped, they should still be evaluated by Propel Rx to determine if a DA or DB intervention code should be auto-inserted.
  - DA should auto-insert if the prescription was submitted to a government plan earlier in the billing path.
  - DB should auto-insert if the prescription was submitted to a private plan earlier in the billing path.
  - Both DA and DB should auto-insert if the prescription was submitted to a government and private plan earlier in the billing path.

If the DA or DB code is manually removed, it should not automatically re-insert upon Fill.

**Interim Solution:** patient should manually submit the receipt to the secondary third party plan.

### Reports

- The Scanned Rx Image report should no longer require a patient or group to be specified prior to its generation.
